The Setouchi specialty "Momoemu" was born in the warm climate of Setouchi.

It was born in 1949, shortly after the war, when it was still a Japanese confectionery shop "Kumi-po Gonta", and was sold under the name of "butter manju".

The manju made by wrapping egg yolk filling in biscuit dough made with a lot of butter and baking it was considered a very luxurious confectionery at the time and was well received.

In the late 1950s, the founder Okada Untaro's Tokyo painter friend tasted this "butter manju" at the time and said, "This is a poem." The painter friend must have felt the poetic feeling from the taste of the confectionery.

Later, the sound of "poem" was converted into the Chinese characters "mother", "hui", and "meng", and the name "Momoemu" was born.
